Most international students will need to take the TOEFL as part of their admissions requirements, but minimum score requirements differ between institutions. Find out if you need to take the TOEFL and what the minimum score requirements are by contacting the schools to which you are applying.

Admission to law school is increasingly competitive, so you need to make your case for admission a good one. This means using the application's essay, recommendations, and supplemental statements to highlight your best qualities.

Applications and Deadlines

Know your application deadlines and keep them in mind as you schedule your time to prepare.

Don't miss a single deadline.

For schools with rolling admissions, you should treat the first day the school accepts applications as your deadline. Why? The longer you wait to submit your application, the fewer the spots that remain. Plus, getting your application in early will increase your chances of financial aid. While the application period may last into spring, the deadlines for financial aid, such as merit-based fellowships, often arrive earlier.

The Rest of the Application Package

You'll need more than just great timing to be successful with your law school applications. According to a former law school dean, "The LSAT score drives the process...unless there are other concerns raised. It's the most critical part of any application. Second place is the GPA at the undergraduate school."

Chances are your GPA is set in stone, so if you have yet to take your LSAT, heed this advice: prepare, prepare, prepare. Whether you go to a class, meet with a tutor, or study independently, make sure you've identified your weak spots, practiced on real tests, and decided on your strategy before you take the exam.

Once you've got the LSAT covered, the bulk of your time can be spent on the subjective pieces of your application package, such as your personal statement and letters of recommendation.

Quick Tips for Improving Your Logical Reasoning (Arguments) Score

It's easier to find wrong answers than correct ones.

Be aggressive when you eliminate. There will be times when the only reason you choose one answer is because the other four don't fit.

Slow down when you're down to two answers.

You'll often find yourself in situations like this and here is where the real work begins. Find a solid, concrete reason why one answer is better than the other. If you can't, choose the answer that first seemed correct to you.

Logical Reasoning (Arguments)

Reading Comprehension

Almost as soon as we learn our first rudiments of science, we are told that all living beings are formed from cells, that cells come into existence from the growth and division of preexisting ones, and that they may exist singly as unicellular organisms or as part of immensely complicated organisms that may contain millions of interacting, highly specialized units. It has been their potential for great diversity of size, shape and function that has allowed evolution to proceed in such strikingly different directions.

Consider for example the extraordinarily complex changes in cellular shape that accompany the movements of fibroblasts. These connective tissue cells are the principal makers of the extracellular matrix that helps glue together the tissues of multicellular organisms. Within animals, fibroblasts must be constantly prepared to move into areas of newly forming tissue. Removed from the animal and grown in culture, they are accessible to microscopic analysis, and the morphological changes that accompany their passage from one point to another have been extensively documented through cinematographic analysis.

The isolated, well-fed single fibroblast is thus revealed not to be a restless, apparently unsatisfied creature unable to stay quiet but instead internally programmed to move. It and all its progeny will continue moving and growing until the flat surface of the plastic dish is covered with a single layer of closely packed cells. Moving fibroblasts bear a resemblance to amoebae with their extending pseudopodia (false feet) that we first saw in our early school science classes, but the details of their respective motions are different.

Quick Tips for Improving Your Analytical Reasoning (Games) Score

Just do something.

When a game or a particular question stumps you, keep working. Try possibilities, work through the answer choices one at a time—do something that promotes progress. Sitting and staring in frustration has never solved a game.

Move on when you know you've got a correct answer.

If you eliminate A and B, but you're sure C is right, don't bother with D or E. Take advantage of the fact that Games is the only section where you can be absolutely certain an answer is correct (as long as you have double-checked your clues).

Quick Tips for Improving Your Reading Comprehension Score

Don't count on your memory.

Some people think it's a waste of time to go back to the passage to find the exact sentence that justified an answer, and they couldn't be more wrong. On most questions you should be able to point to the exact place in the passage that indicates your answer is correct. Taking the little time this requires will save you valuable points.

Don't invent.

When you're working on a reading comprehension passage, the only thing you know is what's there on the page. You'll come across some answers that *could* be correct: avoid the temptation. Correct answers will be very close to what's said in the passage.

25 Fibroblast movement is initiated by the rapid, virtually frenetic throwing out of filamentous extensions (microspikes) and sheetlike projections (lamellipodia). Each of these projections can make firm attachments to the underlying surfaces ahead. Such attachments lead to a forward flow of the cell's cytoplasm and its enclosed nucleus. Many more such locomotor protuberances are pushed out than ever make firm attachments. This is so that large numbers of potential adhesion points can be sampled, with firm unions made only at the most favorable sites.

30 The capacity of fibroblasts for long persistent solo excursions is not a property of all cells. When, for example, single epithelial cells of the sort that line our intestines or skin are placed in culture, they show no tendency to move about. The locomotor behavior of a given cell type thus appears to be highly foreordained and, like virtually all other cellular events of consequence, is hardly ever left to chance. As a result, the exact final position of a given cell within a multicellular organism arises from myriad well-regulated biochemical steps that effectively give the cell no choice but to come together harmoniously with other cells in a particular configuration.

40 To understand how these logical steps unfold, we clearly must probe beneath the cell surface. We now possess the highly sophisticated microscopic, biochemical, and genetic engineering procedures to let us tackle on virtually equal odds the cell's almost overwhelming complexity.
